JOURNEYMAN

A journeyman means a person who has either:

- 1). Completed an accredited apprenticeship in his/her craft, or
- 2). Completed the equivalent of an apprenticeship program in length and content of work experience and all other requirements in the craft which has workers classified as journeyman in the apprenticeable occupation.

For the WBFAA UATC, a journeyman is a person who has taken and passed the State of California Fire/Life Safety Certification Exam.

BENEFITS FOR A JOURNEYMAN REGISTERED IN THE WBFAA UATC

There are advantages for a journeyman who participates in the WBFAA UATC Journeyman Program. These include:
